It works by detecting grid disconnection and automatically shutting down the inverter, which stops the local generation of electricity.

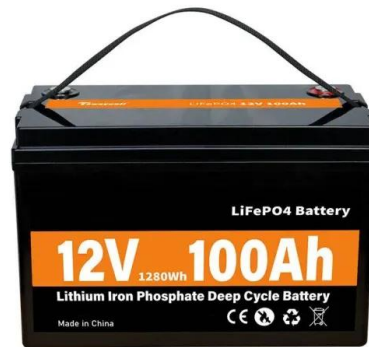

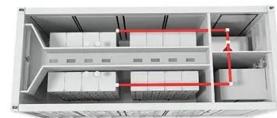
São Tomé and Príncipe
