A one-time rebate on the cost of installing a system is not taxable income. If you qualify for the federal solar energy credit, you must reduce the price of the system by the amount of your local rebate so you only claim a credit on the net amount.

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Rebates from your utility company: Typically, subsidies from your utility company are excluded from income tax returns. 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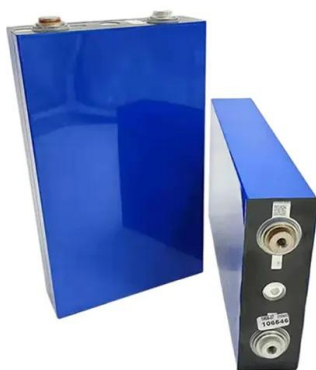

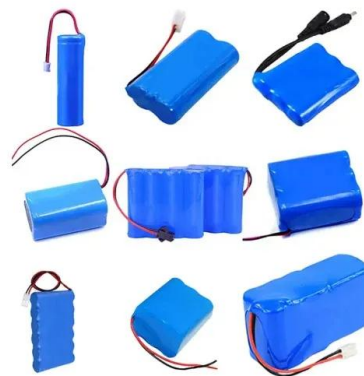
