# Can carrots be frozen



## Overview

Are frozen carrots as nutritious as fresh carrots?

Frozen carrots will taste just as good as fresh carrots in any cooked dish. Just make sure that you freeze fresh carrots right away if you don't plan on using them or keep them in the fridge until you freeze them. This way, the carrots will remain fresh until frozen.

What is the best way to prepare frozen carrots?

Spread the carrots out on a baking sheet. Position the carrots on the baking sheet in a single layer, making sure that they do not touch one another or overlap. If the carrots overlap at all, they will end up sticking together upon being frozen.

What grade of frozen carrots is most commonly used?

Use good carrots. Choose fresh carrots that are young, tender, and free from any blemishes. Medium-length carrots generally work best. True "baby" carrots are a small variety of carrot and do not retain their flavor as well during the freezing process, but technically, they can be used, too.

How long does it take to cook frozen carrots?

Mix together the honey, maple syrup, onion powder, garlic powder, cayenne pepper, salt, pepper and vinegar and pour over the carrots. Mix well with your hands so that all of the carrots are coated. Spread the carrots out across the baking sheet so that the heat can circulate between them. Bake for 20 minutes. Turn after 10 minutes. Serve hot.
