somewhere dry will be fine. no need to cover it. We keep ours in garbage cans with bungee cords to keep the animals out. Metal garbage cans work best. I put mine next to my goose pen, and cover it with a tarp on the bottom and top. Best to keep it totally dry but AIRY (not in a bag or can) if at.

The first step in storing your straw bales is selecting an appropriate site. You should choose an area that's well-drained, out of direct sunlight, and away from any potential sources of fire or ignition. The berries' color, flavor, aroma, and nutritive value will start to decrease after about a year. For longer storage, you can keep well-wrapped dried strawberries in the freezer. For best flavor and quality, use within 2 years of frozen storage. Check dried strawberries occasionally during storage to make sure the product is still dry.

How do you store strawberries?

Store the fruit in the crisper drawer of your refrigerator. Keep strawberries packaged in closed plastic clamshell containers or place fruit in a partially opened plastic bag to maintain high humidity. Do not wash berries until just before eating or preserving. Washing will add moisture and will cause the berries to spoil more rapidly.

What is dry storage & how does it work?

Dry storage is where you store foods that don't require time-temperature controls for safety. This includes items like cereals, flour, grains, canned foods, and other packaged foods. Dry storage is also where you store single-service items like disposable utensils, containers, straws, and plastic wrap.

You can't drink through a straw in a sealed container because the straw creates a vacuum within the container, making it difficult to displace the liquid with air.

### How do you store straw?

Best to keep it totally dry but AIRY (not in a bag or can) if at all possible -- straw is pretty prone to mold, and keeping it enclosed is just asking for mold problems.
