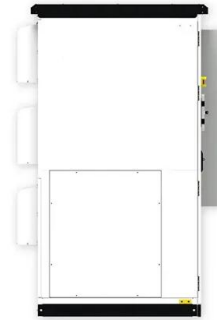


RPC, Sungrow and Suvic to build 50MW/100MWh Finland BESS
