What's going on with the Cuban Fire?

Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel said crews have taken control of the area where the fire is burning and are taking further steps to quell it. "They are not easy tasks," he said. "It is an intense and complex incident."

How does Cuba produce electricity?

The eight-tank facility plays a crucial role in Cuba's electric system: it operates an extensive oil pipeline that receives Cuban crude oil that is then ferried to thermoelectric plants that produce electricity. It also serves as the unloading and transshipment center for imported crude oil, fuel oil and diesel.

Is lightning causing thunderstorms in Cuba?

Cuba's Ministry of Energy and Mines said Saturday morning that lightning was the culprit, and the government later released a satellite map showing a bright red cloud of thunderstorm activity over the province, also called Matanzas.

What's going on with Havana's Blaze?

The blaze comes just days after the government announced scheduled blackouts for the capital of Havana amid a sweltering summer. "The economic effects are clear," said Tahimi Sánchez, a 48-year-old cafe owner. "They are there, we will notice them and we will see them, but we are confident, and we are going to come out of all this well."
