In a major win for homeowners in California, the State Supreme Court ruled that utility companies will have to increase payments to homeowners for excess power generated by rooftop solar panels. As LAist reported, in 2022, state regulators decided to cut payments by 75% to homeowners who produced.

The State Assembly on Tuesday night voted in favor of AB 942, a bill that would strip protections for solar panel systems installed before 2023. Advocates say energy rates are too high, and solar systems are largely to blame for increased power costs. Opponents say the bill will discourage.

California's solar panels are driving up electricity bills for residents while making power cheaper for customers in other states. The Golden State is producing more solar power than it can use, leading to significant energy waste and financial losses. Over the past 12 months, California curtailed.

Due to a change in state law, homeowners, who had received retail prices for selling their excess solar power to the grid, now will be paid wholesale prices, which in some cases approach zero. Homeowners could invest in battery storage to sell the power at a more advantageous time, but battery.

Will California's Solar Energy Bill Hurt Californians if they sell their homes?

The utility-backed bill would force more than 300,000 low- and moderate-income Californians who invested in solar panels after April 2023 to potentially lose tens of thousands of dollars when they sell their homes. Almost one quarter (24%) of homes have solar in California, according to the Solar Energy Industries Association.

Will California renege a million rooftop solar commitments?

The California State Assembly's Appropriations Committee passed a bill that would renege more than a million commitments to the state's rooftop solar customers.

Are wealthy Californians getting too much energy savings?

"This is not the story that utilities tell of wealthy Californians getting too much savings," Brad Heavner, executive director of the California Solar and Storage Association said during Wednesday's committee meeting. "This is working class California trying to stabilize their energy rates.

How much does rooftop solar cost in California?

The CPUC Public Advocates Office released a report on how it arrived at the \$8.5 billion price tag for rooftop solar. However, a report from M.Cubed Consulting and the California Solar and Storage Association said this analysis was flawed and found that rooftop solar provided a \$1.5 billion net benefit to all California ratepayers.
