Can a solar installer roll over a tax credit?

If you lease your unit through a solar installer you will not qualify for the tax credit that allows you to roll over remaining tax credit amounts (assuming you are unable to claim the entire credit in a single year) as long as the tax credit remains in effect. Originally, the ITC was a 30 percent tax credit that stepped down to 26 percent in 2020.

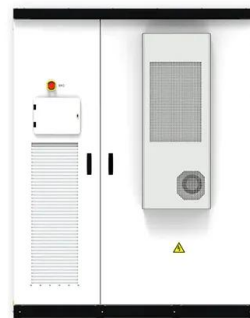

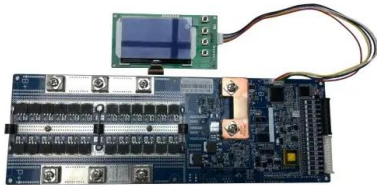

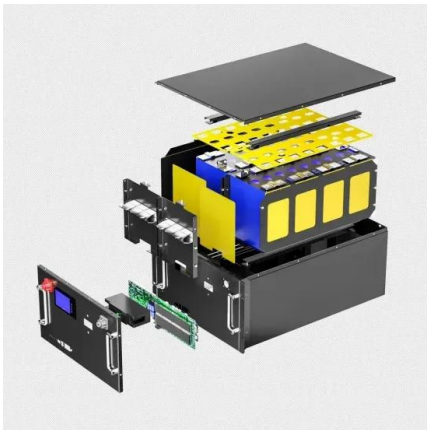
