TECO offers a net metering program for customers who own or lease solar panels and have them installed on their property. This program allows participants to sell excess solar energy back to TECO.

Does TECO provide tax incentives for solar panels?

TECO does not offer any direct incentives to reduce the cost of solar panels. However, all Floridians can apply for the federal solar tax credit, and there are property and sales tax exemptions for solar panels in Florida.

Does TECO have a net metering program?

TECO's net metering program is available to people who own or lease solar panels and have them installed on their property. It is a better deal for eligible TECO customers out of the two solar programs.

Are TECO's Sun select and net metering programs the same?

TECO's Sun Select and net metering programs are both available in 2024. However, they are not identical. Sun Select lets customers support solar energy in TECO territory but comes with an additional cost on monthly bills. The details of each program and their differences are subject to change.

Does TECO have a fuel charge on their bills?

Unfortunately, TECO is adding a new "Clean Energy Transition Mechanism" charge on customers' bills, which partially covers the fuel charge. The fuel charge itself has barely changed in TECO territory between 2010 and 2022, but rates are being raised for the next few years.

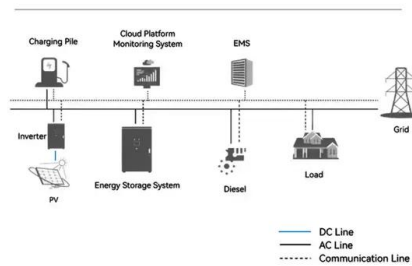
