Europe needs energy storage



Overview

Energy storage is a crucial technology to provide the necessary flexibility, stability, and reliability for the energy system of the future. System flexibility is particularly needed in the EU's electricity system, where the share of renewable energy is estimated to reach around 69% by 2030 and 80%.

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To achieve the EU's climate and energy targets, decarbonise the energy sector and bolster Europe's energy security, our energy system needs to undergo a profound transformation. The rapid deployment of a hugely increased share of variable renewable energy sources will require more flexibility.

A total of 11.9GW of energy storage across all scales and technologies was installed in Europe in 2024, bringing cumulative installations to 89GW. According to the ninth annual edition of the European Market Monitor on Energy Storage (EMMES) from trade association European Association for Storage.

The Energy Storage Coalition emphasises that energy storage is essential to address these challenges, enabling Europe to fully harness renewable energy sources. Doriana Forleo, Executive Director at the Energy Storage Coalition

commented: “ The success of the energy transition depends on energy.

The Renewable Energy Directive (RED) sets a binding target of 42.5% of renewable energy in final energy consumption by 2030. As a result, around 70% of Europe’s electricity mix will be made up of renewable energy. This creates a massive need for higher for short-, medium-, and long-term storage. Should energy storage be regulated in Europe?

As renewable energy continues to expand in Europe, energy storage must keep pace to ensure the grid remains flexible and stable. The Energy Storage Coalition urges the European Commission to develop an Action Plan on Energy Storage, providing much-needed regulatory clarity and supporting Member States in scaling up energy storage capacity.

What is the European energy storage inventory?

In March 2025, the Commission launched the European Energy Storage Inventory, a real-time dashboard that displays energy storage levels across different European countries. It is the first European-level tool of its kind and offers energy storage data across a full range of technologies.

Should the European Commission adopt an energy storage action plan?

The European Commission must adopt an Energy Storage Action Plan within a broader Flexibility Package, to harmonise markets, remove regulatory barriers, and ensure storage is integral to national energy strategies.

What does the European Commission say about energy storage?

The Commission adopted in March 2023 a list of recommendations to ensure greater deployment of energy storage, accompanied by a staff working document, providing an outlook of the EU’s current regulatory, market, and financing framework for storage and identifies barriers, opportunities and best practices for its development and deployment.

How much energy storage capacity does the EU need?

These studies point to more than 200 GW and 600 GW of energy storage capacity by 2030 and 2050 respectively (from roughly 60 GW in 2022, mainly in the form of pumped hydro storage). The EU needs a strong, sustainable, and resilient industrial value chain for energy-storage technologies.

Why is energy storage important in the EU?

It can also facilitate the electrification of different economic sectors, notably buildings and transport. The main energy storage method in the EU is by far 'pumped hydro' storage, but battery storage projects are rising. A variety of new technologies to store energy are also rapidly developing and becoming increasingly market-competitive.

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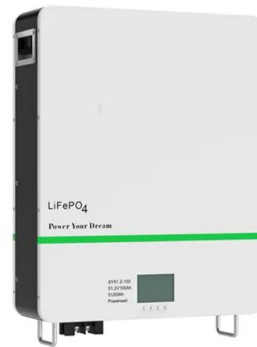

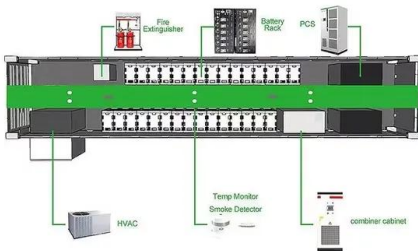

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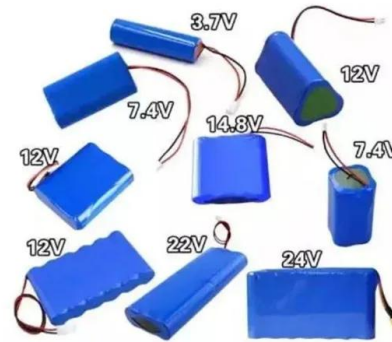
