Our findings contribute to a more nuanced understanding of the role of political factors in shaping renewable energy acceptance.

Do solar installations affect political attitudes?

The results show no signs of meaningful effect of solar installations on political attitudes. Individuals living in solar households do not become more or less interested in politics. Neither do they experience a change in their political position, trust in government or party identification.

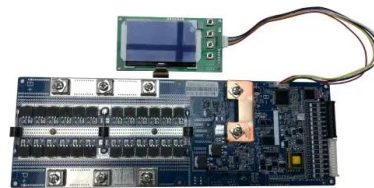

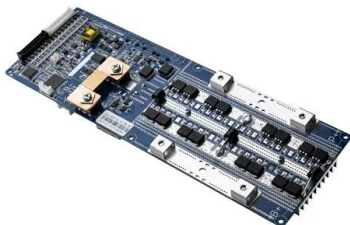
