# How much does duke energy pay for solar



## Overview

Starting Oct. 1, customers with Tier 1 solar panel systems (generating 10 kW or less) will have to pay a minimum of \$10 a month for electricity, even if they don't use any from the grid. Duke Energy Carolinas (DEC) customers will pay 28 cents per kW each month, while Duke Energy Progress (DEP).

The RSC rate is open to new customers indefinitely. It also features a non-bypassable charge and minimum bill, as well as a grid access fee (depending on

CHARLOTTE — Starting Oct. 1, North Carolina is changing the way owners of residential solar panels get paid for the energy they produce, and, specifically, how much Duke Energy will pay for it. Since 2000, Duke customers with residential solar panels have been able to take advantage of something called net metering.

Does Duke Energy offer solar rebates in North Carolina?

Duke Energy offers rebates to North Carolina customers who want to install a solar panel system. For homeowners, the program offers a \$0.60/Watt rebate for systems up to 10 kilowatts. The benefit is equivalent to \$3,600 for a 6 kilowatt (kW) system. Nonresidential customers also have access to rebates of \$0.50/Watt to \$0.75/Watt.

Does Duke offer a time-of-use solar system?

Instead of a flat rate, Duke customers with solar will shift to a time-of-usage system, which compensates them for excess energy the panels produce based on the cost of energy at the time it's produced. The timing for customers shifting to that system depends on when they installed their solar.

Does Duke Energy offer a solar bill savings calculator?

Duke Energy created a Solar Bill Savings Estimator calculator for customers to use to determine which rate fits them best. The nameplate capacity of a customer's system is limited to the lesser of their estimated maximum monthly kW demand or 20 kW for both NMB and RSC.

How does Duke pay for electricity?

When the panels produce more energy than the household can use at the time, the electricity goes back to the grid.
