A 400-watt panel can generate roughly 1.6–2.5 kWh of energy per day, depending on local sunlight. To cover the average U.S. household's 900 kWh/month consumption, you typically need 12–18 panels. Output depends on sun hours, roof direction, panel technology, shading, temperature and age.

How many kWh does a 300W solar panel produce a day?

We can see that a 300W solar panel in Texas will produce a little more than 1 kWh every day (1.11 kWh/day, to be exact). We can calculate the daily kW solar panel generation for any panel at any location using this formula. Probably, the most difficult thing is to figure out how much sun you get at your location (in terms of peak sun hours).

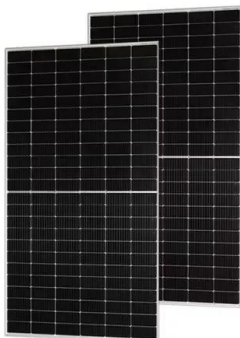
