Overview

Does Ireland use wind?

In 2020 Wind provided over 86% of Ireland's renewable electricity and 36% of our total electricity demand. It is the second greatest source of electricity generation in Ireland after natural gas. Ireland is one of the leading countries in its use of wind energy and 2nd place worldwide in 2020, after Denmark.

What are Ireland's offshore wind targets?

The offshore wind targets set by the Irish Government signal the country's commitment to renewable energy by recognising the significant offshore wind potential that Ireland possesses, says Sean Casey, EY Ireland energy and infrastructure consulting leader.

How many offshore wind projects are developing in Ireland?

Sean Casey, energy and infrastructure consulting leader, EY Ireland: 'Currently, six projects totalling a capacity of 4.2 GW are actively developing offshore wind projects in Ireland; four of these projects have submitted planning applications, with three due for a decision from An Bord Pleanála in December 2024'.

Is Ireland a good place to start a wind project?

Ireland isn't starting from scratch. Wind energy companies spearheading current projects bring vast international experience. The opportunity is there to leverage this expertise while adapting it to the Irish environment and circumstances.

Can Ireland be a global leader in offshore wind?

This is an example of the lack of co-ordinated management in delivering our climate change commitments. Ireland has an opportunity to become a global leader in offshore wind. We have the resources, the technology, and the potential. What we need now is decisive action.

Will Ireland's offshore wind target be met by 2030?

The Government's offshore future framework document has set targets of 5GW of offshore wind installed by 2030, rising to 20GW by 2040 and 37GW by 2050. To put those figures in context, Ireland has 5GW of onshore wind farms installed across the country after decades of development. It is now fairly clear that the 2030 target will not be met.

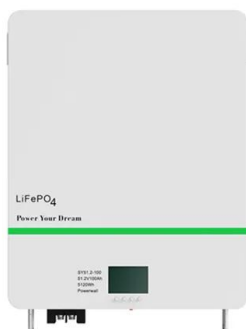
