cannot or do not wish to install home solar panels and still benefit from solar energy.

Duke Energy does not offer solar incentives or rebate programs for its customers. However, Duke Energy customers can take advantage of the federal solar tax credit if they qualify. The federal tax credit equals 30% of installation costs and directly reduces what you owe in federal income taxes.

Duke Energy Florida offers net metering, which means that customers can receive credit for excess solar energy at the full retail rate of electricity.
