Originally, Portuguese merchant-explorers in the 15th and 16th centuries divided the west coast of Africa, very roughly, into four "coasts" reflecting resources available from each coast. The coast which they named the Costa do Marfim--meaning "Coast of Ivory", and translated into French as Côte d'Ivoire--lay between what was known as the Guiné de Cabo Verde, so-called "Upper ...

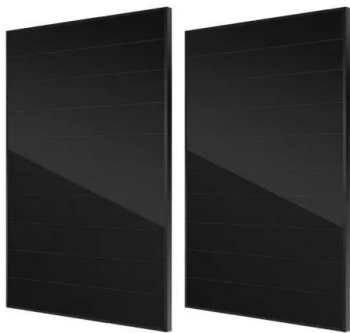
