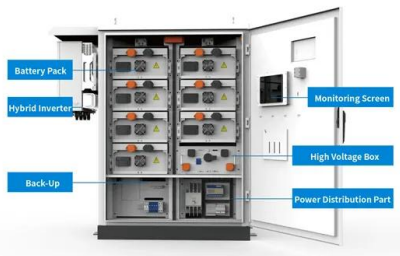
Morocco launches 400MWh solar plus storage tender
