Overview

What is national energy security?

Developed Western countries established the International Energy Organization (IEA) in 1947, officially proposing the concept of national energy security for the first time. Prior to the 1980s, the concept of national energy security mainly emphasized two aspects: energy supply security and price stability.

Who owns the national strategic reserves?

The national strategic reserves belong to the state, and the government makes decisions with the main purpose of ensuring stable oil supply; The commercial reserves of enterprises are completely owned by them, operated independently, with the main purpose of ensuring production and profitability.

How long does it take to refill the energy reserve?

With SPR levels at their lowest in over four decades, his administration has committed to rebuilding the reserve not just as an emergency asset, but as a cornerstone of U.S. energy policy. According to Secretary of Energy Chris Wright, it would take about \$20 billion and five to six years to refill the reserve completely.

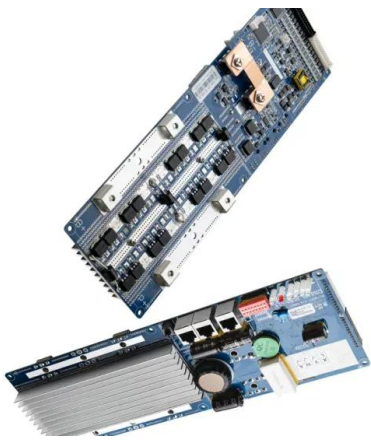

H.R.2650

Energy Independence Act - Title I: Naval Petroleum Reserves - Declares it to be the policy of the United States to fully explore and develop the Naval Petroleum and Oil Shale Reserves and to create with the petroleum and revenue produced therefrom a National Strategic Petroleum Reserve capacity.
