Why is Pitcairn important?

The opening of the Panama Canal in 1914 put Pitcairn on a key shipping route. Ships brought tourists and trade, ending the island's isolation. Over time, some islanders left for New Zealand and Australia, but the issuance of postage stamps in 1940 provided the island with the funds to develop public amenities.

How does Pitcairn make money?

Tourism has emerged as Pitcairn's most significant private revenue source, generating income through the sale of souvenirs, honey, and other artisan products, as well as homestay services for visitors. Pitcairn's government is the primary employer on the island, with most working-age residents employed through the Pitcairn Public Service.

How much does the government pay in Pitcairn?

Pitcairn's government is the primary employer on the island, with most working-age residents employed through the Pitcairn Public Service. Government positions often pay NZ\$10.00 per hour, and many employees hold multiple jobs to meet living expenses.

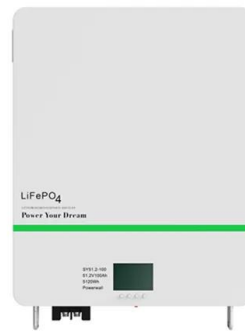
