# Solar container price quotation in Serbia 2026



## Overview

---

The Ministry of Mining and Energy of Serbia is organizing the second round of auctions for market premiums for wind and solar power projects.

The Ministry of Mining and Energy of Serbia is organizing the second round of auctions for market premiums for wind and solar power projects. The quotas are 300 MW and 124.8 MW, respectively. Maximum prices are both much lower than the first time. For the second time, Serbia is launching auctions.

Serbia's government has set quotas for the second round of renewable energy auctions, with specific capacity limits for wind farms and solar power plants. The quota for wind farms with a capacity of over 3 MW is 300 MW, while the quota for solar power plants with a capacity of more than 500 kW is.

The settlement prices were €64.48 per megawatt-hour (\$68/MWh) for wind and €88.5/MWh for solar. Serbia's electricity market liberalization began in 2004, with the unbundling of generation and transmission. Yet this liberalization remains incomplete, with 87% of the generation capacity still.

The Ministry of Mining and Energy of the Republic of Serbia published the public call for auctions for awarding of market premiums (in the form of CfD) for wind and solar projects earlier today (Wednesday, 14 June 2023). As per an earlier announcement, the total quota for premiums amounts to 400MW.

Backed by EBRD and SECO, Serbia's second renewables auction allocated 645 MW of wind and solar capacity, with competitive prices starting at €50.9 per MWh for solar. Investors have submitted 41 proposals in Serbia's second auction, which has exceeded the 424.8 MW quota, and the total awarded.

There are seven applications in the wind power segment and 33 for solar power Bids for an overall 1,171 MW were submitted, compared to a total quota of 424.8 MW. In the first auctions, bids were placed for 602.8 MW while the quota was 450 MW. The available quota for wind power projects is 300

MW.

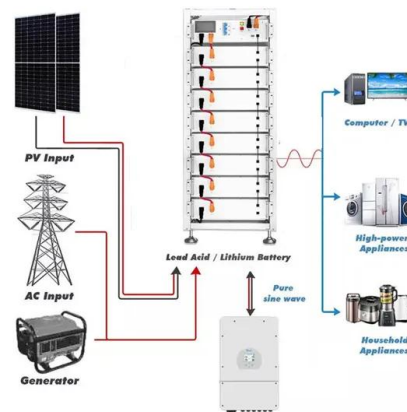
