In Gambia's case, the supply is far from dependable; it is erratic to say the least. The issue is unreliable energy supply marred with interminable load sharing derived often from inextricable scheduled maintenance of the power machines.

Who is responsible for energy consumption in the Gambia?

The government is not limited to the central government but also the two municipal and regional governments in all five regions in the country. The central government coupled with the regional governments across the Gambia put together are undoubtedly responsible for the consumption of a significant energy percentage (%) output of the grid.

Supreme Court. 1. Establishment and Constitution: S.125(1) of the Constitution provides that -"Within eighteen months of the coming into force of this Constitution, there shall be established a Supreme Court of the Gambia which shall consist of - (a) the Chief Justice; (b) not less than four other Justices of the Supreme Court;
