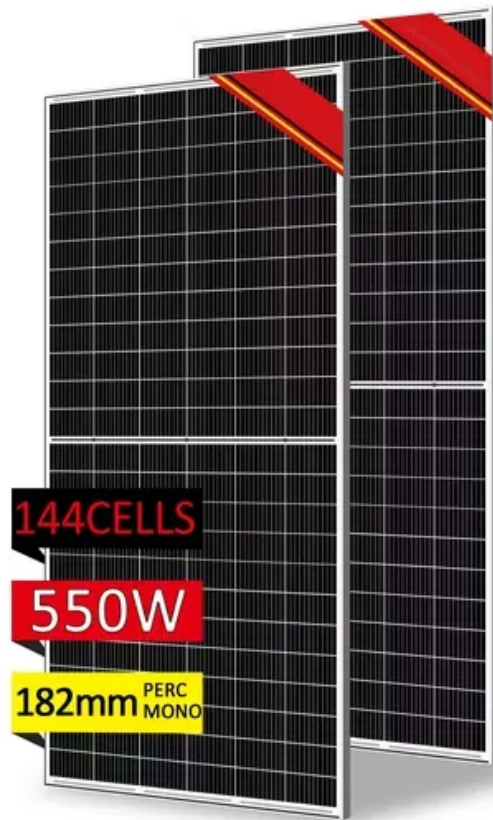

Overview

What happens if Ukraine doesn't have power?

For millions of Ukrainians, the absence of power can mean no running water, air conditioning, lifts or access to life-saving equipment. Over the past three months alone, Ukraine has lost nine gigawatts of generating capacity, the national energy company Ukrenergo says.

Will the US help Ukraine withstand Russian strikes on energy infrastructure?

Meanwhile, the EU and U.S. recently earmarked a combined \$112 million in energy equipment and building for DTEK, the private Ukrainian power company. The aid is supposed to help Ukraine continue to weather Russian strikes on energy infrastructure, the most recent of which was on Nov. 17.

How much energy assistance has Russia given to Ukraine?

The scale of the ongoing work to fix the sector is huge. Since the start of Russia's full-scale invasion in 2022, the G7 and other allied countries have allocated more than \$4 billion in energy assistance to Ukraine, U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken said in September.

What happened to Ukraine's thermal power plants?

The images showed thermal power plants destroyed by Russian forces, the workers fixing them, and the impact on Ukrainian life, including darkened streets and surgery without proper lighting. "We in Ukraine are living through dark times, literally," said Serhiy Morgunov, one of the photographers, at the event.

Who owns Ukraine's energy plant?

For months now, she and her colleagues have returned to the plant every day to fix it and help keep the lights and heat on as winter sets in. This plant is owned by DTEK, Ukraine's largest private energy supplier. It says Russia has attacked its facilities nearly 200 times since the Russian invasion in February

2022.

Does Ukraine need emergency energy support?

Led by the Ukraine government, energy repairs have swung into action, gas turbines are spinning, the lights are coming back on. Most importantly, emergency energy support is helping to protect lives and livelihoods, even in the most difficult of circumstances. But more is needed.

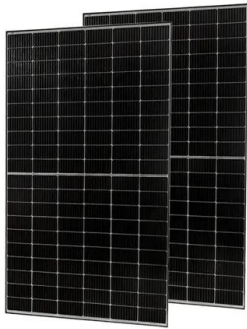
