Port storage charges start once the containers are discharged and end once they gate out of the port. 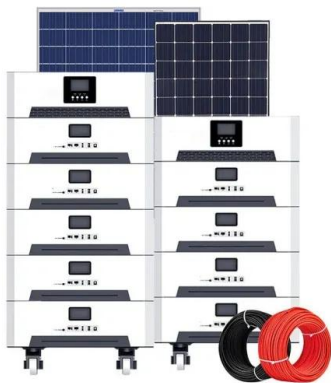
