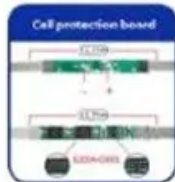

When does Trump's solar tax credit end?

However, Trump's bill ends the solar tax credit on Dec. 31, 2025 — cutting off nine years of potential savings for consumers who were considering certain renewable energy systems. The end-of-year deadline also drastically reduces the time people have to schedule qualifying installations.

Will a 30 percent solar credit expire?

The 30% credit has long been the biggest single incentive for residential solar panel adoption, and its expiration is a significant blow for what has been a fast-growing industry. For homeowners, its elimination significantly changes the calculus of whether solar panels make financial sense compared with paying utility electrical rates.

Will a solar tax credit end in 2025?

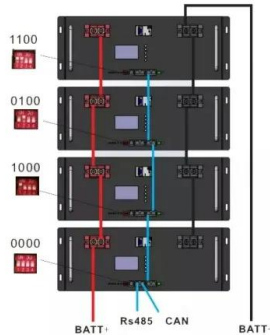
May 13 update: The House Ways and Means Committee is proposing an end to the residential solar tax credit as part of the reconciliation process. If passed, systems placed in service (i.e., installed and inspected) by December 31, 2025 will still qualify for a 30% tax credit.

When does the 25D solar tax credit end?

On July 4, was signed into law by President Trump. After some back and forth, both Chambers of Congress agreed to end the 25D residential solar tax credit

after December 31, 2025. Residential solar systems installed by this deadline would still qualify for a 30% federal tax credit.

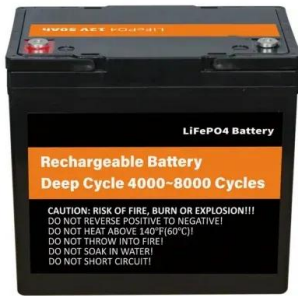

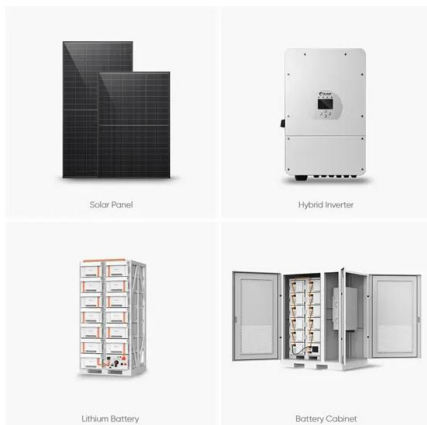
